2012 BOOSTER BASKETBALL PLAYOFF INFORMATION

1. It's up to each league commissioners (and their coaches) to make sure that the playoffs run smoothly and that all leagues finish up before February school vacation this year.
2. Please remember that practices for everybody end on Thursday, January 27th since we need most of the gyms for playoff games. No team may practice at any of our assigned schools after this date.
3. All assigned playoff schedules must be adhered to. Please let all parents know your leagues playoff schedule now so we do not have any travel games, birthday party or other conflicts. If you do, deal with them and explain that the games are not going to be changed, no matter what travel soccer and or travel basketball is doing. We will only change games due to weather cancellations.
4. There must be an assigned commissioner from the league present at every playoff game and sitting at the scoring table (that commissioner cannot be coaching in the game being played) so they can resolve any conflicts that might arise.
5. Please make sure you instruct your coaches and parents to remain calm and collected in the heat of battle. Remember, this is Booster Basketball and not the NBA Finals. Show good sportsmanship and refrain from yelling at the refs and complaining about calls. The refs will be instructed to be very strict in regard to giving out technical fouls to coaches for obnoxious behavior and to players who are out of control.
6. Please make sure all teams arrive no later than 15 minutes prior to game time so we can start the games on time. Games must start within 5 minutes of the end of the previous game or if you are the first game, within 5 minutes of the scheduled starting time. For the Championship games, as soon as your game is concluded, let the next game start warming up as you do your trophy presentation towards the side of the court.
7. You must have a parent and or community service child doing the clock who understands the rules of your league and that has done the clock during the season.
8. You must have an official scorebook and a competent parent at every game who carefully tracks personal fouls, team fouls, segments played, violations and technical fouls so there are no problems later in the game. It is vital that *all* of these items are tracked carefully during the game. In the past we have run into many arguments over fouls and segments played in the playoffs. You must have a scoreboard at each game so the parents always know the score.
9. Please make sure that when trophies are available that each commissioner pick them up from the trophy committee and that you have your trophies available at your championship game so everybody gets their trophy that night.
